

# HAMPSHIRE SCHOOL GAMES MARK

## KEY STAGE ONE—GOLD

### PARTICIPATION

Provide all pupils with two hours of physical education and school sport each week

Provide a programme of OSH activities beyond the curriculum to include lunchtime, breakfast and after schools activities

Provide opportunities for talented young people to challenge themselves using appropriate resources and activities

### MINIMUM TARGETS

- Two hours of timetabled PE within the curriculum for all pupils
- Accessible to all young people
- Engage at least 40 % in extracurricular sporting activity every week
- Signpost appropriate activities and clubs within a community setting
- Attend appropriate competitive events

### COMPETITION

Hold a School Sports Day that celebrates the Level One competitions that have taken place over the year

Boys and girls take part in appropriate competitions

Competitive opportunities are promoted to parents and pupils

Noticeboard and website are used to promote competitive opportunities

- At least one Sports Day to be held during the academic year that is accessible to all pupils
- Engage pupils in FOUR Level One festivals
- Engage pupils in THREE Level Two festivals
- Enter more than one team in the same festival (i.e. 'B' team) in at least TWO events
- Produce a calendar of competitive opportunities that are published on the website
- Events are promoted to school community and parents at least once per half-term
- Notice board with photos, reports etc and website articles are updated every month

### WORKFORCE

Create opportunities and training for Year 2 pupils to become playground leaders

Pupil Voice is used to discuss and develop an Action Plan for PE and School Sport

Opportunities available for Adults Other Than Teachers (AOTTs) to support school sport via training

- 10% pupils identified and trained as Playground Pals or leaders and are actively supporting identified sessions
- Pupils to meet on at least one occasion to discuss and develop ideas for PE and School Sport
- At least one member of non-teaching staff and /or volunteers has attended training and is supporting PE and School Sport within your school

### CLUBS

Have a school-club link / agreement between the school and a community based sports club

- Have active links with at least THREE local sports club
