

Home School Learning For Year 1 - Autumn 2 2017

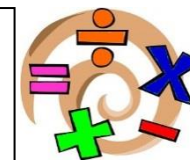
This half term our topic is **Light It Up!**- A4 size work should be stuck in Home-School liaison books. Large homework should be brought to school during the week beginning Monday 18th December.

The grid below contains nine different activities that your child can complete at home to support their learning at school. We would like your child to try and complete **a minimum** of one row of three home-learning activities by the end of the half term. The row can be horizontal, vertical or diagonal but must pass through the centre square. You can use the home school liaison book to report back and stick work in where appropriate.

Art/craft activity - Design and make a Christmas card for your class.	Science - Can you create a dark box that has a light source to it?	Writing task - Write a winter poem.
Science - Can you create a weather diary for a whole week that includes the temperature, weather and any seasonal changes?	Non negotiable task - Read home reading book AT LEAST 3 times a week. Begin to learn phase 5 sounds.	Geography Research - Can you draw a map of your local streets and label any shops or special houses etc?
Reading - Can you challenge yourself to read a book from the local library each week and report on your favourite one?	DT - Can you make a new vehicle for Father Christmas to carry everybody's presents in?	Maths activity - Can you create a Christmas wish worth £10? (grown ups to help by rounding totals up to the nearest pound.)

Maths and English

- Writing in sentences using capital letters and full stops.
- Beginning to include conjunctions in sentences (and, because, but, so).
- Correctly using the weekly spellings in their writing.
- Learning phase 5 letters and sounds.
- Measurement
- Geometry - 2D and 3D shapes
- Addition and Subtraction (through money)
