<p>Children will develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination and develop a range of art and design techniques through ;</p> <p>Drawing Observing and recording the shapes, patterns and textures found in objects. Working in a combined schematic and observational way with confidence in placing objects.</p> <p>Painting Showing control in the use of colour. Adding colour, pattern and texture to objects. With guidance add detail to work. Combining materials and tools and enjoy finding out how to achieve different effects. Understand that paint is used in different ways for different effects.</p> <p>3D/Sculpture Using a range of modelling materials squeezing, pinching and rolling to make familiar or fantasy objects (clay) Working on a larger scale when appropriate. Joining simple objects together.</p> <p>Textiles Weaving on simple frames different effects Sorting, matching and naming different materials. Collecting materials and ideas for work and experiment with materials before using them. Using paints, dyes, crayons and other media to make individual and group designs on textiles.</p> <p>Printing Using printing to illustrate and explore ideas, commenting on what is done. Develop work from initial studies and investigation.</p> <p>Collage Mixing paper and other materials with different textures and appearances. Showing a developing understanding of the qualities of the materials used. Recognising that materials look and feel different, choosing the most suitable materials for an effect.</p>	<p>Children will develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination and develop a range of art and design techniques through ;</p> <p>Drawing Combine schematic and observational approaches. Observe how shape, colour and tone can be used to describe form. Representing objects with correct proportions. With guidance, adding detail to work. Begin to use pencil shading to create light and shade.</p> <p>Painting Exploring the tactile and visual qualities of a paintbrush. Mixing paints from a limited range. Making some independent decisions about colour.</p> <p>3D/Sculpture Exploring materials. Using clay to join parts together using slip and score technique.</p> <p>Textiles Exploring materials according to colour, texture, different types of materials. Simple stitching</p> <p>Printing Using objects and basic tools and equipment to make patterns and images. Working within a range of processes, controlling materials and tools.</p> <p>Collage Using cut and torn papers and other materials to make simple patterns and images.</p>
