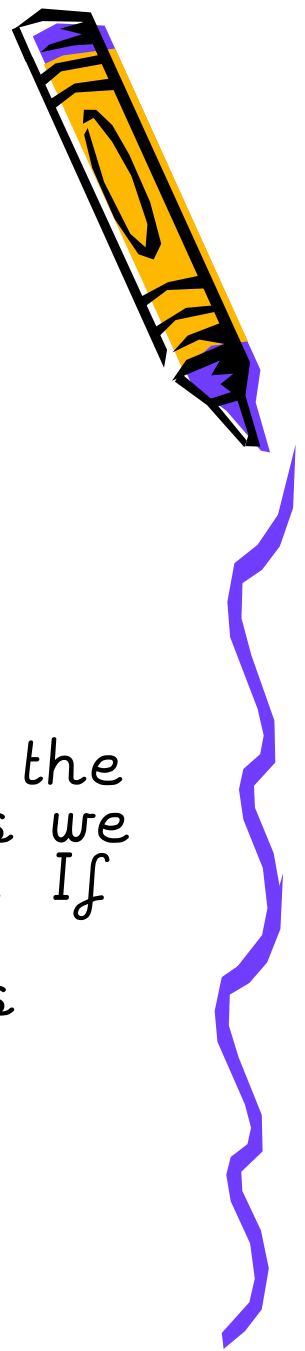


Welcome to Year R

# Reading



- Bookmarks
  - sign if they have read at least once each day
  - When they have filled 1 bookmark they get a sticker in assembly
- Relax and Read morning
  - every Monday morning 8:30-8:45am (please tidy reading books away at 8:45am for the usual school day to begin)
  - You can come in and read with your child, and change their book with your child
- Changing books
  - We aim to change books once/twice per week when we have read with your child
  - Please always bring your child's reading book to school

- Half termly homework will begin at October half term.
- Grid format with 9 home learning activities.
  - One will be non-negotiable which must be completed
  - Children can then choose 2 others to complete, or more if they wish
  - Add these to your child's tapestry account, or bring into school
