

When an individual child is isolating at home with family

First 2 full days of isolation
2 day emergency pack based on key learning from maths and English units plus foundation lessons.



Normal class teaching will continue within the bubble



From Day Three the child will receive the resources that have been used in class, a day behind their peers. Where possible, video clips either from class or online will be shared.



Child returns to school and with some support to establish progress at home is able to reconnect with class learning.



From parent feedback school can see that the first day of isolation is usually spend trying to organise testing and other household tasks that need to be organised for the family for the start of isolation. For this reason we do not expect work to be completed on this first day.

Each maths and English Learning Journey will have a two day emergency pack of materials linked to it and planned in advance.

By the end of the first day of the reported isolation parents will receive;

- Link to online resources to support the next 2 days of learning.
- Physical resources to support the next 2 days of learning where appropriate.
- An overview of the content of the next 2 days of learning
- Guidance on how to collect physical materials from school safely if required.

From day 3 of the isolation parents will receive;

- Regular work packs continuing the work their child is missing in school with links to support its' delivery at home,
- Information on how to contact their child's teacher for support.
- Guidance on how to collect physical materials from school safely if required.
- Information on how to submit their child's work for feedback safely where required.

When a whole bubble and members of staff need to isolate

First 2 days of isolation
2 day emergency pack based on key learning from maths and English units plus foundation lessons.



During the two days where children are using the emergency packs at home, teachers will use this time to adapt the core of their current learning journey into remote teaching and learning.



From Day three of the bubble closure children's planned learning journeys will continue via remote learning with a mixture of virtual teaching and physical resources.



On bubbles return to school remote learning will be blended back into classroom teaching to complete/continue learning journeys.



Each maths and English Learning Journey will have a two day emergency pack of materials linked to it and planned in advance.

On the day of the bubble closure (where closure is from start of school day) parents will have received;

- Link to online resources to support the next 2 days of learning.
- Physical resources to support the next 2 days of learning
- An overview of the content of the next 2 days of learning
- Guidance on how to collect physical materials from school safely if required.

On day 3 of the bubble closure parents will have received;

- Link to online resources to support the next block of learning.
- Physical resources to support the next block of learning.
- A timetable overview of the content of the next block of learning
- Information on how to contact their child's teacher for support.
- Guidance on how to collect physical materials from school safely if required
- Information on how to submit their child's work for feedback.
