In Science, we'll be:

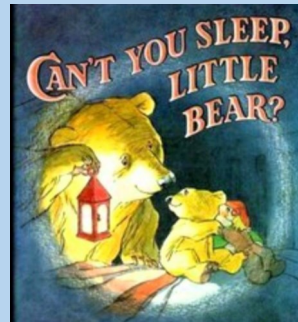
Seasonal Change - observing changes across the four seasons & observing and describing weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.
